

Procedures in the event of a suspected infection of an employee or a student

1. A person with suspicious disease symptoms should be immediately dismissed and isolated from other people in a prepared room/space.
2. The health condition of an isolated person should be monitored on an ongoing basis (telephone or personal contact with a selected person – university employee/other student).
3. If an isolated person does not require medical assistance, he or she should go home or to a place of isolation in the place of residence, using their own transport or transport provided by the University.
4. In the case of students and doctoral students, the Dean for Students Affairs and the Team for SARS-CoV-2 should be notified, and in the case of health deterioration, an ambulance should be called and the district sanitary and epidemiological station, and the Team for SARS-CoV-2 should be informed about the situation.
5. If a student or a teacher experiences disease symptoms, the area in which the person was operating should be determined and thorough cleaning thereof should be ordered immediately, including the disinfection of door handles, handles, handrails, floors, etc. and other objects/devices which were used by the person.
6. The indicated sanitary and epidemiological station should be informed about the case and, depending on the case, the recommendations of the district sanitary inspector for the implementation of additional procedures should be followed.
